

At a Glance:

- We are a **FREE reading intervention program**
 - Serving low-income, 4th grade students of color
 - In the greater Los Angeles area, including Compton
- **Interrupting the school to prison pipeline**

Impact:

- **Giving kids the foundation they need for a lifetime of reading success:**
 - J3 students' standardized assessment [scores increased by 36 points](#) in 2021-22
 - Exceeded (iReady's) expected reading growth by 57% , or 1.5 grade levels
- J3 also [excels](#) at:
 - Creating Good Study Habits
 - Building Self Confidence
 - Increasing Book Access

Continued Growth & Reach:

- 2018: 1 school / 25 students →
- **2024: 16 schools, across 3 school districts, anticipating 700+ students** served 2023-24

Donor Impact:

Strong Investment: J3 [invested 1.2 million dollars](#) into the program in 2022-2023

- **Students: \$1,500** per student annually
 - Books, resources, supplies, quality education
- **Single School Program: \$36,000** annually
 - Each year-long Cozy Reading Club program **is free to both students and schools**
- **\$100,000 Contribution: 3 Additional Schools**
 - This level of funding would enable J3 Foundation to provide our Cozy Reading Club to **120 students**
